Recap of the Technology Team's Work: Over the past months this team as worked on two key things:

- 1. *Reviewed our Values:* (Based upon Worship Survey Results)
- Meaningful Sermons, Communion & Hymns/Songs
- Worship Participation Sharing Faith Stories

- Accessibility
- Consistency
- Children in Worship
- Special Music

Sound Quality

- Reaching Out/Evangelism/Meeting Needs of POC and Immigrants other worship times/formats
- 2. Asked the question "What are the ways we can Enhance Worship Life?". A list was created and priorities were determined.

The Priorities in order of importance were...

- 1. Wireless Microphone Update to reduce interference with Cell Towers (completed)
- 2. Sound Balance, Optimization of Sound System (in process, seeking quote)
- 3. Choir Microphones for small group (in trial phase, hope to purchase soon)
- 4. Video Presentation System

Proposal to Enhance Worship Life

The Technology Team proposes that we seek the funding of Worship Upgrades for the approximate amount of \$25,000 to go towards Optimizing the Sound System, Choir Microphones and a Video Presentation System in the Sanctuary.

Estimate: Optimization - \$2-3,000 Choir Microphones - \$600-1,000 Video Presentation System - \$21,000 Total: \$25,000

Next Steps:

Step 1: Information Meeting for Congregation to gather feedback

Step 2: Council Proposal – May 21 - The Council will discuss this proposal at the next meeting. If the proposal is approved the council would also approve the solicitation of funding for the project. *(Project would not move forward until majority of funding is secured)*

Step 3: Funding Secured - When the funding is secured, at that point the Technology Team would recommend to the council a specific vendor, plan and detailed cost estimate.

Step 4: Select Vendor and finalize details of the project.

Step 5: Council approves the proposal, hires the vendor and approves the use of the funds.

Step 6: Vendor completes the project. Upgrades are implemented along with pre-work and post work to make the updates esthetically pleasing.

Step 7: Training, Set up and Organization of Technology.

Step 8: Incorporate Worship upgrades into congregational life.
